NOTIONES - iNteracting netwOrk of inTelligence and securIty practitiOners with iNdustry and acadEmia actorS

Emerging technologies offer both opportunities and challenges for intelligence practitioners, as they can be leveraged for advancements in the intelligence process but also exploited by malicious actors, including terrorists. Thus, staying abreast of the latest technological developments and understanding their implications is paramount for effective intelligence operations.

Funded by the European Commission's Horizon 2020 Framework Program, NOTIONES is a 60 months project that addresses H2020-SU-SEC-2018-2019-2020 call. It aims at establishing a network that connects researchers, industries, and professionals in the fields of security and intelligence. This network will facilitate the exchange of insights on emerging technologies, ensuring that solution providers are equipped with a deep understanding of practitioners' needs.

To elicit the specific requirements of intelligence and security professionals, NOTIONES will collaborate closely with end users across Member states and associated countries. Through this collaboration, the project NOTIONES aims to identify the challenges faced by practitioners in adapting to technological advancements and incorporate their feedback into the development process.

Moreover, to ensure the project's relevance and effectiveness, NOTIONES will continuously monitor and analyse emerging technologies relevant to intelligence and security practitioners. The insights gleaned from this research monitoring will inform discussions within the working groups and guide future research directions.

The consortium of NOTIONES is led by <u>Tecnalia</u>: <u>Research center | Technological development, TECNA</u> Spain, being technically supported by <u>Zanasi & Partners, Z&P</u>, Italy, and comprises a total of 29 partners from 21 countries. The project had a kick-off meeting on 13th of September 2021.
